On February 16, we held a Brown Bag Lunch with representatives of the Downtown Oakland Association, to give UCOP employees an opportunity to hear direct from local civic leaders regarding developmental plans for downtown Oakland and to learn how we can help the neighborhood.

On February 23 the UC Office of State Governmental Relations led a discussion on how UC operates in the halls of Sacramento as well as how OP employees can most effectively advocate for UC.
