



## **Campus Update June 2012**

### **UCB Operational Excellence Shared Services Center**

UC Berkeley has signed a lease for a building to house the new Campus Shared Services (CSS) Center. Berkeley's shared services will include certain human resources, finance, research administration and information technology work that is currently being performed in many different locations across campus. In six phase plan, about 170 UC Berkeley staff will move into the CSS Center in the fall of 2012, growing to 500-625 over the next 24 to 30 months.

### **BSA Governing Council Election**

Twelve UCB staff members were nominated and are up for election to become members of the BSA Governing Council (GC). The election process includes web voting ballots that were sent to eligible UCB staff members who have until May 24<sup>th</sup> to vote. Results will be announced at the May 24<sup>th</sup> GC meeting.

### **BSA Selects Staff Representative to the Chancellor Search Committee**

President Mark Yudof requested BSA to name a staff representative to the committee that will advise him on the selection of a new Berkeley Chancellor. Paul Riofski, a UCUSA alum, was voted in and will attend committee meetings and deliberations, which will start in May.

Staff Advisors to the Regents, Penny Herbert and Kevin Smith and UCOP Working Smarter Director, Cathy O'Sullivan participated in this ongoing BSA forum.
