Members of Staff Assembly along with fellow members from Staff Assembly and the Chancellor's Advisory Council on Staff were given the opportunity to meet with the search committee and offer perspectives regarding the opportunities and challenges that the new chancellor will face. Faculty and Staff giving Campaign – “Elevate UCI”

Staff Assembly is involved in the sponsorship and promotion of an awareness campaign. The focus of the campaign is to increase the percentages of Faculty & Staff who give back not a dollar goal. The goal of the program is to increase the participation rate of internal donors to 20% to better demonstrate to external stakeholders that we are proud to invest in our community. Staff will be able to donate to funding programs that directly impact their fellow staff members. The UCI Staff Relief Fund, an initiative from the Chancellors Advisory Committee on Staff, provides financial assistance and resource recommendations for UC Irvine Staff members, at the campus and medical center, who are experiencing an immediate, severe and temporary financial situation due to an emergency or unforeseen or unavoidable event. The UCI Staff Relief offers a one-time distribution of funds up to a maximum of \$500 for eligible staff. Staff can also donate to the Staff Assembly Career Enhancement Scholarship program.

Global Equity Games

20 teams consisting of faculty, students and staff –worked together to solve seven challenges including brainteasers, design and build temporary structures, and juggle and balance familiar and not so familiar objects. Campus offices and programs as well as faculty, student and staff organizations set up informational tables and booths at the event. Staff assembly hosted a booth and participated in the challenges.
