Mission/Vision Statements

The Berkeley Staff Assembly Coordinating Committee formed a subcommittee at the beginning of 2007-2008 to evaluate and propose an update to our Mission and Vision statements. The subcommittee has done a great deal of very thoughtful work and BSA will incorporate its new statements before the beginning of 2008-2009.

Excellence in Management Awards

BSA's popular Excellence in Management (EIM) awards were given on May 12, 2008 to supervisors who were nominated by their supporting staff members. The theme for 2008 was "Riding the Wave of Successful Succession" and honored supervisors who incorporated succession planning in their management methods.

Elimination of Dues -- Transition

BSA voted to eliminate dues in 2007 and is now making the transition from a dues-paying to an opt-in, non-dues-paying organization in 2007-2008. A transition team has worked on communication and publicity issues as well as funding and fundraising ideas to recoup the small amount of income that BSA earned in dues payments.
