

**University of California Office of the President Staff Assembly “Campus Update”  
(for the June 2010 Meeting of the Council of UC Staff Assemblies – CUCSA - Meeting)**

In the past quarter, the UC Office of the President Staff Assembly has hosted two “Town Hall” meetings with UC President Mark Yudof and UCOP staff. Because OP staff work in one of four office locations (Franklin Building, Kaiser Building, 20<sup>th</sup> Street, and the APL Building) – none of which have an auditorium - these meetings were held at a state office building in Oakland. The meetings were also webcast, and questions were solicited in advance from staff. The meetings provided a valuable opportunity for President Yudof and key members of the senior staff (including EVP Nathan Brostrom and VP Dwaine Duckett) to hear from staff and invite future input on key issues. Also in this past quarter, OPSA’s Chair and Vice Chair met with EVP Brostrom to introduce him to the work of the Assembly and discuss future plans. EVP Brostrom agreed to find funding for OPSA to host the September 2010 CUCSA meeting, and to work with us to improve morale, performance management, professional development, and other issues of concern to staff. Finally, OPSA worked on publicizing its upcoming elections, seeking nominees for up to eight seats on the Steering Committee. Elections will be held before mid-July. In addition to the above activities, OPSA has continued to work with other UCOP staff groups (the UCOP Cares volunteering effort, the President’s Advisory Committee on the Status of Women, and others) on joint projects and planning for future efforts.
