SAIC Makes \$4 Million Gift To The Beyster Institute At UCSD's Rady School Of Management

The University of California, San Diego announced today a gift of \$4 million from Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) to the Beyster Institute at the Rady School of Management.

New Scripps-based Research Program to Analyze Ecosystems of the California Current

\$5 million granted for program to understand processes important for California's ocean ecosystems, climate and resource management. Building upon a half century of research, scientists at Scripps Institution of Oceanography at the University of California, San Diego, and their colleagues have embarked on an unprecedented effort to uncover the mechanisms underlying changes in the ecosystems off California's coast.

Moore's UCSD Cancer Center Awarded Grant to Plan Public-Private Drug Development Center

The National Cancer Institute (NCI) has awarded a one-year planning grant to the Rebecca and John Moore's UCSD Cancer Center to study the feasibility of creating a novel public-private center to speed the process and reduce the cost of developing new drugs and diagnostic techniques for cancer patients. The Cancer Center was one of only 14 planning grant recipients nationwide.

UCSD Biologists Develop 'Super-Endurance' Strain Of Mice

Biologists at the University of California, San Diego have transformed ordinary laboratory mice into the rodent equivalent of Olympic endurance athletes by deleting a gene that allows mammalian muscles to switch from aerobic to anaerobic metabolism when oxygen levels in the muscle run low.

Top Pharmacist at National Institutes of Health Joins UCSD as Pharmacist in Chief, Associate Dean

The top pharmacist at the National Institutes of Health (NIH), Charles E. Daniels, Ph.D., comes to the University of California, San Diego (UCSD) October 1, 2004 in the newly created position of Pharmacist in Chief for UCSD Healthcare. In addition, he will serve as Associate Dean for Clinical Affairs and Professor of Clinical Pharmacy in the UCSD School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences.

UCSD Receives \$131.9 Million in Private Support to Help Launch New Schools & Initiatives FY 2003-2004

Campus Exceeds its yearly goal to ensure educational opportunity and enrich student life through UCSD's Campaign which has raised over \$600 million towards the \$1 billion goal. The University of California, San Diego (UCSD) today announced that private support for fiscal year 2003-2004 amounted to \$131.9 million, making it the second most successful year in the history of the campus. (In fiscal year 1999-2000, the campus received \$135 million in private support).
