1. Strategies for Increasing Diversity

The Center for Gender Equity and the Chancellor's Advisory Committee on the Status of Women will sponsor Dr. Joan Reede as a keynote speaker on March 1, 2005 at the Campus Library. Dr. Reede will address "Strategies for Increasing Diversity". Dr. Dean is the Dean for Diversity and Community Partnerships at Harvard Medical School. She is the first African-American woman to hold a position of that rank and Harvard Medical School and one of the few African-American women to hold a deanship at a Medical School in the United States.
