Chancellor's Advisory Committee on Child Care Conducts Survey

The Chancellor's Advisory Committee on Child Care conducted a survey in January to reassess the evolving childcare needs of UCSF families. The committee was seeking recommendations for additional childcare centers at the UCSF campuses and/or remote locations such as the East Bay and information on alternate care options, including after-hour school programs, holiday and non-traditional hours of need and youth programs. The results of the survey will be shared with UCSF campus administration and assist in developing short and long term goals for UCSF childcare services and programs.

In April 2001, Chancellor Bishop appointed the committee to oversee implementation of a campus child care policy. The Committee conducted a child care needs survey in 2002 which resulted in a 200% increase in enrollment slots at UCSF childcare centers, and the construction of two new childcare centers.

Staff Council at UCSF Hosts Presentation on Staff Advisor to the Regents Program

The Staff Council at UCSF hosted a presentation on the position of staff advisor to the UC Regents. UCSF's David Bell, the 2005-2006 staff advisor, talked about the position, the application process and his experience in the position.

UCSF Academic Business Officers Group (ABOG) Accepting Applications for Mentoring Program

The ABOG Mentorship Program began accepting applications for the '07-'08 program. Staff were invited to brown bag forums held at three different sites to learn about the program. The program pairs high-level, seasoned UCSF managers with members of the campus who are interested in pursuing specific career goals, expanding their professional network and receiving feedback and support that could help them to better navigate the UCSF system.
